

The Kahnawà:ke COVID-19 Task Force

December 23, 2020

Directive 55 - Retail Business Closure December 31, 2020 - January 31, 2021

Due to the global Pandemic COVID-19, the current state of emergency and the increased risk of transmitting the virus, the Kahnawà:ke COVID-19 task force is directing that certain retail and manufacturing businesses in Kahnawà:ke will be required to close from **December 31**st, **2020** at midnight to **January 31**st, **2021**.

Closures will include:

- o All Cigarette/ Tobacco Stores (No curbside pickup)
- o All Factories who do not provide essential products (No curbside pickup)
- Hair salons and aesthetics
- All other retail stores may provide curbside pick-up and delivery to Kahnawa'kehró:non
 ONLY; please note that online sales are permitted
- Businesses that can remain open:
 - o Grocery and Convenience Stores (No cigarette sales to non-locals)
 - Restaurants and food services (Pick up and delivery)
 - Pharmacies
 - Hardware Stores
 - Massage therapy, physiotherapy, acupuncture, reflexology:
 Any Person who gives therapeutic body care such as massages and treatments in order to correct physical disorders and stresses of the human body
 - Gyms
 - o Construction, electricians, plumbers and trades, and movers
 - o Hotels
 - Pet food and supply stores
 - On-line services
 - o Media and telecommunications
 - Auto mechanical repairs
- All gas stations, convenience and grocery stores in the community are not permitted to sell tobacco products to non-locals.

This measure is put in place to help minimize the spread of the virus within our community and to help protect our most vulnerable. Working as a community, we can limit and manage its spread.
