CHURCHES, FUNERALS, CEREMONIAL GATHERINGS, (INDOOR & OUTDOOR)	No restrictions on capacity, Masks** required indoors
INDOOR PRIVATE GATHERINGS	12 persons maximum Masks** recommended if vaccination status is unknown.
OUTDOOR PUBLIC GATHERINGS	50 people provided space permits based on distancing recommendations Masks* recommended if vaccination status is unknown
ORGANIZATIONS	Phased in return to office
SPORTS	According to preapproved association/league/school safety standards
HALL RENTAL	Hall rentals are permitted in accordance with distancing and masking and proof of vaccination requirements. Exemptions can be made on case by case basis for education, health or social support groups.
PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION	Masks* required by customer(s) and driver
LIVE MUSIC / KARAOKE / SHOWS	Permitted provided Public Health Measures are respected

Masks * - 3-ply medical or medical type mask are recommended for all masking requirements.

Preventative Measures: Exclusion of symptomatic workers from the workplace (daily health check), Physical distancing- 3 feet (1M) apart, masks indoors as per public health measures if distancing is not possible and when moving around, hand washing, maintenance of hygiene measures for tools, equipment and frequently touched surfaces, physical barriers where required, and special measures for establishments when required. All businesses are subject to an inspection. **Capacity**: is based on maintaining recommended distances between tables and/or Clients, inspection may be required.
