



# The Kahnawà:ke COVID-19 Task Force

February 10, 2022

A State of Emergency has been in effect since December 20<sup>th</sup>, 2021. It will expire on February 20, 2022, and we will move into a recovery phase of the emergency. The Covid-19 situation is stabilizing and in preparation for the recovery phase the following Directives will be in effect as of February 14, 2022:

## Restaurants, Cigar Lounges, Social Clubs & Bars:

- No capacity limits based on tables distanced 6 feet apart between different groups
- Proof of vaccination required (*currently being reviewed*)
- Masking required for all employees
- Masking for customers when not seated

## Gaming:

- No capacity limits
- Proof of vaccination required (*currently being reviewed*)
- Mask required at all times for employees and customers

## Indoor and Outdoor Private Gatherings

- No capacity limits
- Masks recommended

## Hall Rentals

- No capacity limits based on tables distanced 6 feet apart between different groups
- Masking when not seated
- No dancing
- Proof of vaccination required (*currently being reviewed*)

## Retail, Manufacturing, Churches, Funerals, Ceremonial gatherings:

- No capacity limits
- Masks required in doors

## Sports

- According to preapproved association/league/school safety standards

## Public Transportation

- Masks required by all

## Live Music/Karaoke/Shows

- Permitted with public health measures in place

## Organizations

- Phased in return to office to be determined by each organization
